2007 AISEA Conference

Summer 2007 will feature the Ninth Annual Conference, held in Estes Park, Colorado on June 28—July 2, with a welcome reception on the evening of June 28th.

The conference begins with two days of hands-on training workshops by experienced faculty in areas of interest to both new and experienced AIS educators.

It continues with 2 days of research presentation, that include practical, theoretical, and pedagogical materials, all of which have undergone a blind refereed process.

Estes Park, Colorado

Estes Park is the eastern entrance to Rocky Mountains just 70 miles northwest of Denver International Airport. The conference will be held at the Rocky Mountain Park Holiday Inn Hotel at Estes Park, Colorado. Drive through the park atop the highest continuous paved road in the U.S. Stop in at Trail Ridge Store at 11,718' elevation. Estes Park offers a selection of outside activities from mountain biking to hiking to golf. Family activities are also available both before and after the conference.

Conference rate will be \$119 for a hotel room/night and \$199 for a 2-room suite. There is an \$8 extra person charge per night. (There is no extra person charge for children under age 19 staying in same room as parents).

Teaching related work may include educational research, innovative course design, course development or delivery and assignments, cases and projects that can be used by others. Research benefiting AIS practice may include theoretical or applied research. Best papers will be published in our online journal, the *AIS Educator Journal*. Research at early stages of
